

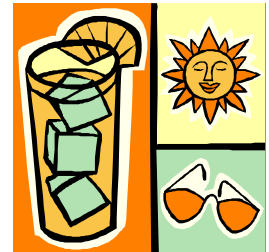

### Planning Underway for Beth Chai's Shabbat & Adult Ed Programs for 2006-2007: Program Committee Welcomes Your Ideas by Ken Jacobson

Beth Chai's Program Committee has tentatively picked the evening of July 20 to talk about topics for our Adult Education series and Shabbat programs for the 2006-07 year. All interested are invited to attend the discussion and encouraged to bring their ideas.

Among the proposals for Adult Ed series that have been discussed in the past — but for which there hasn't yet been time — are a look at the realities of Jewish life in Muslim lands at different historical periods and a comparison of Abrahamic texts in Judaism and Islam. One idea that's new this year is to examine the nature of obligation and the roots of guilt in Jewish religion and culture.



As for Shabbat programs, suggestions have ranged from tracing anti-Semitic symbolism in the vampire myth, including its manifestation in Bram Stoker's classic novel *Dracula*, to delving into the characteristics of Klezmer that make it a distinctive form of music, and a distinctively Jewish form of music.

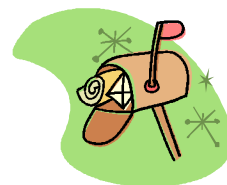
